Newtown Battlefield A Revolutionary War battle on August 22, 1779

Elmira Civil War Prison Camp Site A notorious site in which nearly 3,000 Confederate prisoners died between 1864-1865.

Mark Twain Study & Exhibit The office where Mark Twain wrote Huckleberry Finn.

Woodlawn Cemetery The graves of the 3,000 prisoners are buried there along with Mark Twain.

National Warplane Museum Museum traces aviation from 1919 to the present with an emphasis on WWII, Korean, & Vietnam War era aircraft.

Montour Falls Find the falls that gave its name to the village. Just one of 19 falls along the Watkins Glen Gorge.

Take time to enjoy the wonders of the area.
